## 1. Introduction

This paper presents the total estimated remaining capacity for the disposal of waste to landfill in Scotland as at 31 December 2009. It presents the numbers and capacities of all landfill sites authorised<sup>1</sup> by the Scottish Environment Protection Agency (SEPA) in the calendar year 2009. This covers landfills that were active (landfilling waste) and non-active (not landfilling waste) in this year. The tonnages of waste landfilled in Scotland in 2009 are also presented.

This paper is intended as a snapshot of available capacity as at 31 December 2009 and does not attempt to project future trends in disposal or to assess the potential impact of any changes in waste management practice or policy that may affect future capacity.

## 2. Landfill capacity in Scotland 2009

Under the Landfill Regulations (Scotland) 2003, all landfill sites are required to be classified as hazardous, non-hazardous or inert<sup>5</sup>. Table 1 shows the total numbers and remaining capacities for each type of authorised landfill in Scotland for both active and non-active sites.

In addition to the existing remaining landfill capacity listed in Table 1, SEPA is considering applications for PPC permits in respect of five **new** landfill sites. These are listed in Appendix 4. Please note that sites awaiting determination may or may not be granted a permit and it is also possible that the proposed capacity may be subject to alteration.

### 3. Tonnes of inert and non-hazardous waste landfilled in 2009

In order for landfill capacity figures to be meaningful, a comparison should be made with the quantity of waste landfilled. Table 2 compares remaining landfill capacity with the quantity of waste landfilled in each local authority area for the calendar year 2009, excluding material used for landfill restoration purposes. Hazardous waste is considered in the next section.

#### 4. Tonnes of hazardous waste landfilled in 2009

Avondale hazardous landfill in Falkirk (PPC/E/0020086) is the only site in Scotland specifically permitted to accept hazardous waste. Some 25,117 tonnes of waste were landfilled at this site in calendar year 2009 and the remaining capacity as at 31 December 2009 was 358,056 tonnes.

In addition, 16 non-hazardous sites across Scotland are permitted to accept bonded asbestos waste, as stable non-reactive hazardous waste<sup>6</sup>, consigned in a separate cell. These are identified under the 'stable non-reactive hazardous waste cell' column in Appendix 3.

#### 5. Data sources and limitations

The data in this paper are extracted from SEPA's public register of licensed/permitted sites and from information supplied by landfill site operators. Site operators are required to make returns to SEPA detailing the types and quantities of waste landfilled at their site. The data are reported to SEPA on a quarterly basis using the licensed/permitted site return form, from sites holding a waste management licence (WML) or relevant Pollution Prevention and Control (PPC) permit. Although checks are made, SEPA cannot be held responsible for any errors contained within the data nor for commercial decisions by operators on whether or not to fill an authorised void.

The regulation of landfills under SEPA's powers currently falls between the WML and PPC regimes. Only a few of the landfills listed in Appendices 1 to 3 continue to be regulated under the WML regime while they complete their applications or have PPC permits pending.

No data is presented here for sites which have planning permission but have not yet applied for, or been issued with, a permit by SEPA.

Landfills can accept waste from within the local authority boundaries and from all over Scotland and beyond, so waste landfilled within any given local authority area does not necessarily correspond to the waste produced within that area.

## Appendix 5: Landfill type information note

The Landfill (Scotland) Regulations 2003 set out those wastes which may be accepted in the different classes of landfill, i.e. hazardous, non-hazardous or inert.

1. Waste may only be accepted at a landfill for inert waste if:
  - a) it does not undergo any significant physical, chemical or biological transformations;
  - b) it does not dissolve, burn or otherwise physically or chemically react, biodegrade or adversely affect other matter with which it comes into contact in a way likely to give rise to environmental pollution or harm to human health; and
  - c) its total leachability and pollutant content and the ecotoxicity of its leachate are insignificant and, in particular, do not endanger the quality of any surface water or groundwater.
  
2. Waste may only be accepted at a landfill for non-hazardous waste if it is:
  - a) municipal waste;
  - b) non-hazardous waste which does NOT feature on the list of hazardous waste in the European Waste Catalogue (EWC) 2002.
  - c) stable, non-reactive hazardous waste (such as that which is solidified with leaching behaviour that will not change adversely in the long term, under landfill design conditions or foreseeable accidents, e.g. bonded asbestos)
  
3. Waste may only be accepted at a landfill for hazardous waste if:
  - a) it is listed on the Hazardous Waste List of the European Waste Catalogue or has similar characteristics to those so listed;
  - b) its total content or leachability:
    - a. does not present a short term occupational risk or an environmental risk;
    - b. would not prevent the stabilisation of the landfill within its projected lifetime taking account of its after care period following closure.

#### Not-for-profit organisations

You have the same rights as 'personal use' above. This includes using the information within your organisation. If you supply this information to others, you may charge a fee to recover your costs, as permitted by the Environmental Information Regulations or Freedom of Information Act.

#### Commercial use

You may copy our information for internal use. You may not provide that information outwith your organisation without our written permission. There will usually be an additional charge.

If you are a professional adviser, you may give a single copy of our information to your client (or clients, if they jointly instruct you).

#### Other use

This notice sets out various ways in which you can use our information. If you want to do anything not covered in the notice, you must have our written permission first. Examples of 'other use' include publishing on the internet or using it to promote a commercial service.
