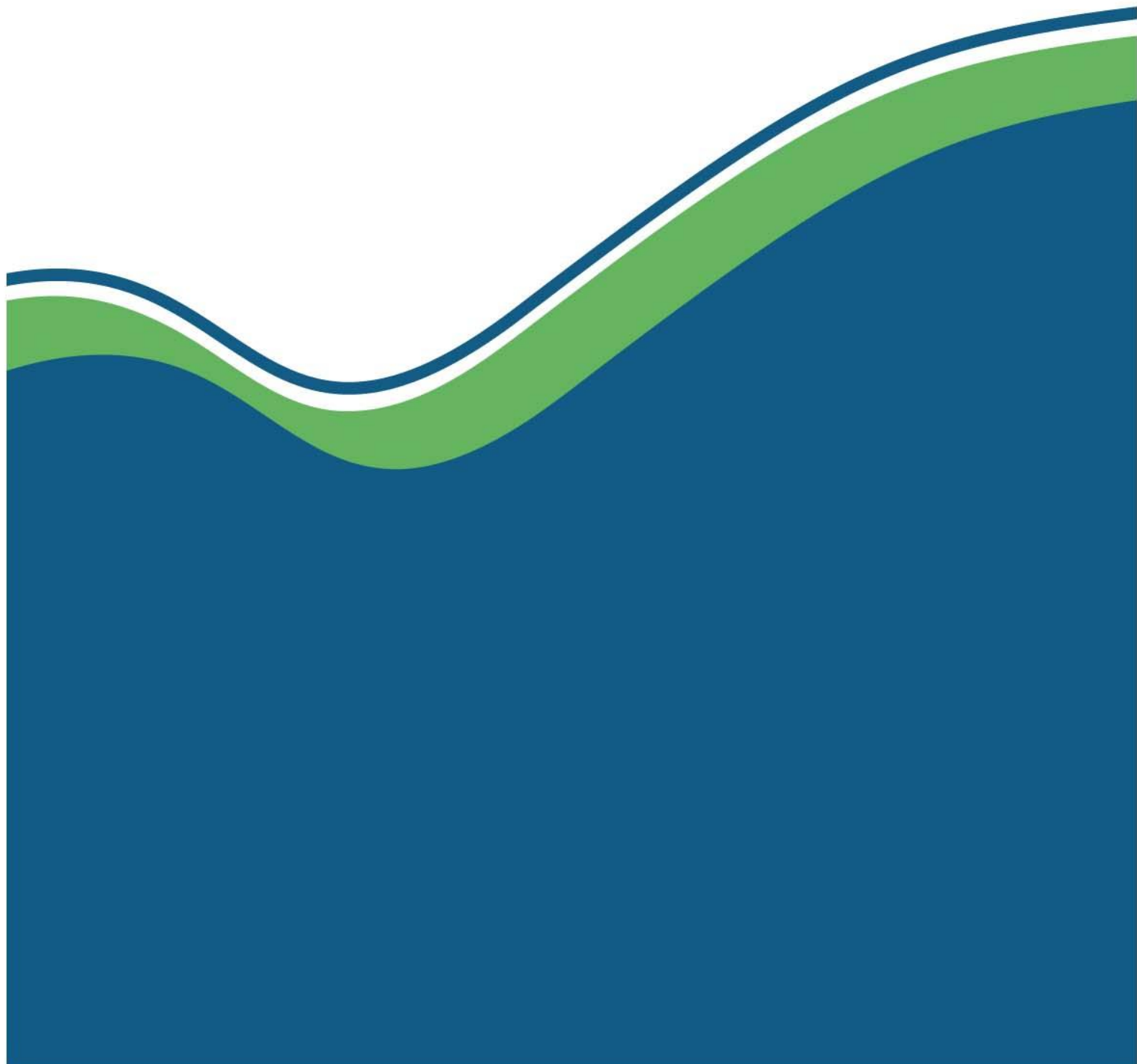

1. Introduction

This paper presents the total estimated remaining capacity for the disposal of waste to landfill in Scotland as at 31 December 2011. It presents the numbers and capacities of all landfill sites authorised¹ by the Scottish Environment Protection Agency (SEPA) and either active (landfilling waste) or non-active (not landfilling waste) in calendar year 2011. The total tonnages of waste landfilled in Scotland in 2011 are also presented.

This paper is intended as a snapshot of available capacity as at 31 December 2011 and does not attempt to project future trends in disposal, nor assess the potential impact of any changes in waste management practice or policy that may affect future capacity.

2. Controlled waste disposed of to landfill in Scotland 2011

The total amount of controlled waste sent to landfill in 2011 was 4,657,206 tonnes. A breakdown of this by region (local authority) and waste type (European Waste Catalogue for Statistics [EWC-Stat]) code is shown in Table 2.

3. Number and types of landfills in Scotland in 2011 with remaining capacities

Under the Landfill Regulations (Scotland) 2003, all landfill sites are required to be classified as hazardous, non-hazardous or inert². Table 2 shows the total number and remaining capacity for each type of authorised landfill in Scotland for both active and non-active sites.

4. Remaining capacities and tonnage of inert and non-hazardous waste landfilled in Scotland in 2011

In order for remaining landfill capacity figures to be meaningful, a comparison should be made with the quantity of waste landfilled. This section considers inert and non-hazardous waste. Hazardous waste is considered in Section 5.

Table 3 compares remaining landfill capacity with the quantity of inert and non-hazardous waste landfilled at active and non-active authorised landfills in each region (local authority) for the calendar year 2011. This total is only for landfill sites that have a remaining capacity.

4. Remaining capacity and tonnage of hazardous waste landfilled in Scotland in 2011

Avondale hazardous landfill in Falkirk (PPC/E/0020086) is the only site in Scotland specifically permitted to accept hazardous waste. Some **45,866** tonnes of waste were landfilled at this site in calendar year 2011 and the remaining capacity as at 31 December 2011 was **342,971** tonnes.

In addition, 17 non-hazardous sites across Scotland are permitted to accept bonded asbestos waste, as stable non-reactive hazardous waste³, consigned in a separate cell. These are identified under the 'stable non-reactive hazardous waste cell' column in Appendix 2.

5. Data sources and limitations

The data in this paper are extracted from SEPA's public register of licensed/permitted sites and from information supplied by landfill site operators. Site operators are required to make returns to SEPA detailing the types and quantities of waste landfilled at their site. The data are reported to SEPA on a quarterly basis using the licensed/permitted site return form from sites holding a waste management licence (WML) or relevant Pollution Prevention and Control (PPC) permit.

The regulation of landfills under SEPA's powers currently falls between the WML and PPC regimes. Only a few of the landfills listed in Appendices 1-3 continue to be regulated under the WML regime while they complete their applications or have PPC permits pending.

This report considers waste from household, commercial and industrial sources.

Landfills can accept waste from within the local authority boundaries and from all over Scotland and beyond, so waste landfilled within any given local authority area does not necessarily correspond to the waste produced within that area.

Although checks are made, SEPA cannot be held responsible for any errors contained within the data nor for commercial decisions by operators on whether or not to fill an authorised void.

No data is presented here for sites which have planning permission but have not yet applied for, or been issued with, a permit by SEPA.

Any minor differences in the tonnage totals within and between this report and the accompanying spreadsheet are due to rounding errors.

Where no licensed/permitted site return form has been received, no estimates have been applied to the missing data.

Appendix 4: Landfill type information

The Landfill (Scotland) Regulations 2003 set out those wastes which may be accepted in the different classes of landfill, i.e. hazardous, non-hazardous or inert.

1. Waste may only be accepted at a landfill for inert waste if:

- a) It does not undergo any significant physical, chemical or biological transformations;
- b) It does not dissolve, burn or otherwise physically or chemically react, biodegrade or adversely affect other matter with which it comes into contact in a way likely to give rise to environmental pollution or harm to human health; and
- c) Its total leachability and pollutant content and the ecotoxicity of its leachate are insignificant and, in particular, do not endanger the quality of any surface water or groundwater.

2. Waste may only be accepted at a landfill for non-hazardous waste if it is:

- a) municipal waste;
- b) non-hazardous waste which does NOT feature on the list of hazardous waste in the European Waste Catalogue (EWC) 2002.
- c) stable, non-reactive hazardous waste (such as that which is solidified with leaching behaviour that will not change adversely in the long term, under landfill design conditions or foreseeable accidents, e.g. bonded asbestos)

3. Waste may only be accepted at a landfill for hazardous waste if:

- a) it is listed on the Hazardous Waste List of the European Waste Catalogue or has similar characteristics to those so listed;
- b) its total content or leachability:
 - i. does not present a short term occupational risk or an environmental risk;
 - ii. would not prevent the stabilisation of the landfill within its projected lifetime taking account of its after care period following closure.
