**RADIOACTIVE SUBSTANCES ACT 1993  
PROPOSED VARIATION OF THE AUTHORISATIONS FOR HUNTERSTON B AND  
TORNESS POWER STATIONS  
APPLICANT: EDF ENERGY**

I am responding to your letter of 3 February 2016 seeking our views on the proposed variation for the movement and storage of solid radioactive waste from Hunterston B and Torness nuclear sites.
