## The Criteria and Procedures for the Acceptance of Waste at Landfills (Scotland) **Amendment Direction 2009**

The Scottish Ministers give the following Direction to the Scottish Environment Protection

Agency ("SEPA") in everyise of the powers conferred by section 40(2)(a) of the Environment

Agency ("SEPA") in exercise of the powers conferred by section 40(2)(a) of the Environment Act 1995(a), having consulted SEPA in accordance with section 40(6) of that Act.
Citation, commencement and extent
1(1) This Direction may be cited as the Criteria and Procedures for the Acceptance of Waste at Landfills (Scotland) Amendment Direction 2009 and comes into force on the day after the date on which this Direction is given by the Scottish Ministers to SEPA.
(2) This Direction extends to Scotland only.
Amendment of the Criteria and Procedures for the Acceptance of Waste at Landfills (Scotland) Direction 2005
2(1) The Criteria and Procedures for the Acceptance of Waste at Landfills (Scotland) Direction 2005 is amended as follows.
(2) In paragraph 17 Table 6 of the Schedule, in the entry for Dissolved Organic Carbon (DOC), for "50,000" substitute "1,000".
