

Five steps to avoiding a fixed monetary penalty

To avoid risking a fixed monetary penalty, please ensure that you notify us of the following changes, within the statutory 28 day period. Send in:

1.



Notification of engineer appointments.

2.



Notification of new reservoir managers.

3.



Notification of relevant works for new and existing reservoirs.

4.



Notification of changes to controlled reservoir information, including contact details and reservoir specific details.

5.



Notification of ceasing to be a reservoir manager.

Be compliant to avoid risking a fixed monetary penalty

From January 2019, SEPA will be introducing fixed monetary penalties (FMPs) of between £300 and £1,000 for reservoir managers who fail to send in notifications within the statutory period.

Compliance is non-negotiable. Don't be caught out, inform us of any changes within 28 days.
