In advance of the update to the current version of MACS-WAT-02 version 3 published March 2019 the following minor amendment to content has been made.

---

7.5.9 Note 2 currently states:

*All additional samples must include the requirement to report to SEPA all parameter data, for all monitoring purposes detailed in the operators AMP, associated with the original sampling event.*

SEPA have reviewed this specification and have decided that when collecting an additional sample, it is no longer a requirement to sample for all parameters and for all monitoring purposes.

It is now only necessary to collect an additional sample for the purpose of obtaining a reportable result for the parameter(s) unavailable from the original sampling event.
