




## Scottish Flood Forecast

The Scottish Flood Forecast is a three-day outlook of where flooding is likely to occur, giving you time to prepare and take action to protect yourself from flooding.

Developed by the Scottish Environment Protection Agency (SEPA) and the Met Office, the Scottish Flood Forecast provides the earliest indication possible of when and where flooding is expected over the next three days, and whether the source is from rivers, surface water or the sea.

The forecast is produced every morning, 365 days a year, and published on SEPA's website.

A colour coded map describes the potential impacts of flooding on our communities so you can take action to protect yourself, your property and adapt travel plans where necessary.








Updated daily from 10:30am - with a further update at 3:30pm if a flooding situation is developing or escalating that significantly changes the risk.

The Scottish Flood Forecast was developed with the help of communities most affected by flooding, emergency responders and partner organisations. It's an accessible, mobile-friendly tool that makes it easy to understand the risk of flooding and gives reassurance when no flooding is expected.

## **Floodline**

The forecast can be used alongside SEPA's Floodline service, which issues shorter notice regional Flood Alerts and local Flood Warnings 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
